◆ 2025 Summer Course: Japanese Conversation Training Contents and Application Method ◆

The course is designed for participants to improve Japanese language skills, especially conversation in short term period. We welcome participants from both abroad and within Japan.

1. About course

(1) About Class

 Duration From Tuesday, July 22nd to Friday, August 8th 2025 (Excluding Saturdays and Sundays)

- * Up to 12 students per level (Level: Beginner, Intermediate and Upper Intermediate)
- * You will be studying in the same level during the course period, and level changes are not permitted during the course. Select a level according to the applicant's level based on the following "Level Guideline".
- * Each level's application is based on a first-come, first-served basis, and application will close when it reaches maximum intake. In addition, depending on application status, we may adjust the number of students, or we may not be able to hold classes.

- (2) Class contents and Class process
- The study materials (textbooks) for each level will be handed to you on the first day of course; July 22nd. You will be studying Japanese conversation with the materials.
- Beginner and Intermediate: Study about 15 lessons from our original textbook + relevant part of the vocabularies + verb form prints.

Upper Intermediate: Study about 10 lessons from our original textbook

- Face to Face (in class) lesson up to 12 students per level
- Aiming for the "Objects" described in the "Level guidelines", we will focus on concentrate short-term lessons according to the "contents".
- Classes will be in Japanese only (no language other than Japanese in the classes)

2. How to apply

To apply for this course, <u>fill out the application form on the Web</u> from the Japan Student Services Organization HP \rightarrow Osaka Japanese Language Education Center \rightarrow "Summer Course". Make sure that the information you enter is correct.

- (1) Each level will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.
 Note that the application will close when each level reaches maximum intake
- (2) Be sure to enter the required input items. (Refer to agreement/acceptance attached) (If you do not enter the required items such as agreement/acceptance, you cannot proceed)
- (3) Attach the latest face photo to the required section.
- (4) Attach an image of your passport or resident card, where your face photo is placed.

 <u>X</u> Acquire visa to enter Japan for the course by yourself.
- (5) Apply from the Web. We do not accept applications by visit to the school.

3. Application period / time

- (1) Application period: From 9:00 a.m., June 17th to 2:00 p.m., July 2nd, 2025 (JST)
- (2) Application hours: For 24 hours during the application period

4. Participation fee

- (1) Participation fee: 65,000 yen/each class of level (including study materials)
- * Pay by bank transfer after invoice.
- * No refund after payment
- * Expenses such as accommodation, transportation, cultural experience in the course (expected to be held) and etc., are not included in the participation fee of JPY65,000.

(2) How to pay the participation fee

Once your application is accepted, we will inform you about the payment.

- * Notifications will be sent to the email address you entered on the "Web".
- * Participation fee need to be settled by bank transfer.

 Note that we don't accept cash.

5. Remarks

- * You need to get your own visa to enter Japan for the course
- * You need to prepare your accommodation to stay in Japan for the course.
